### Location and Centre

Devon is home to some of the UK's finest beaches and traditional seaside resorts, of which Dawlish, on the south coast of the county, is no exception. With a capacity limited to 48 students, OISE Dawlish has a warm family atmosphere which makes it perfect for the younger student and those who are visiting England for the first time.

The school itself is nestled in picture-perfect grounds complete with a trickling stream. Due to its exclusive seaside location, our leisure programme has been specially tailored to include activities on the beach – always a popular option!

The soul behind the Full Study Course lies in the combination of the academic aspects of language development and an understanding of the enthralling world in which it is used. The course reshapes perceptions so that young learners continue to digest language tuition in a manner that excites and interests them. Most prominently, the course imparts an authoritative voice upon students that enables greater confidence in both their native tongue and their new language.





## Accommodation

Accommodation is with host families living in Dawlish and nearby Teignmouth within a five minutes bus or train journey along the seafront to school. All host families are thoroughly inspected and their credentials checked. There will be no other student of the same mother tongue in the house.

## Activities and Excursions

During late afternoons and one evening per week there will be a social activity for all students. Typical activities include film night, barbecue, talent and fashion show, quiz night, art challenge, casino night and theatre workshop.

Every Saturday, there is a full day excursion to a place of historic or architectural interest such as the Barbican Centre in Plymouth, an outing to the National Marine Aquarium or a visit to the city of Exeter. Sundays will be spent with the host family.



## Travel

Young Learners are greeted by members of the OISE courier team from certain airports within standard hours as part of the package. Students are then accompanied to the Welcome Lounge, a facility with food, refreshments and activities to keep students occupied until they are taken onward to the school.
