



OISE Boston Visa Requirements

Determination of visa status

- If the course is 18 hours* or fewer per week, no student visa is required, regardless of length of stay.
*an hour is 60 minutes

Do you require an F-1 student visa? OISE Boston is happy to create I-20 for you, please be aware we need the following information to create this document.

- A written application faxed or emailed to OISE Boston, which includes Country of Birth and Nationality.
- Proof of financial ability. Original documentation is required to prove that a student can pay for the course and for living expenses. A recent bank statement is the most usual form of proof. If the client's company or other organization will pay for the course, a letter from the company to that effect is sufficient. Note that some schools do not ask for this documentation, but in fact it is required by law.
- A deposit of \$500 or full payment.

Please do not forget to include the address you would like us to mail the I-20, a courier fee of \$75.00 applied to the booking.
