Location and Centre

Oxford is home to the world famous Oxford University, the oldest university in the English speaking world with teaching of some form being offered as early as 1096. Since then it has grown into one of the world's most celebrated universities and has given the city a unique scholarly atmosphere, with many academic wonders scattered throughout the city, including medieval college buildings, museums, galleries and bookshops.

Staying residentially at an Oxford University college, students have unrivalled access to one of the most highly regarded educational institutions on the planet. As a result of the dynamic tuition, participations on the Advanced Learner's programme refine their social eloquence and mastery in the specificity of the English language.

There comes a distinct stage in every language journey where a firm foundation has been laid and it becomes pertinent to refine the delivery of the language to perfectly represent the speaker's unique individuality. The Advanced Learner's programme is appropriate for the most studious individuals with an excellent level of English, specifically a B2 C1 aptitude as defined by the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages. The course breaks with conventional language teaching methods to offer a programme that goes beyond what is expected, fully preparing students for University and their professional future.

Students develop superior communication skills by writing nightly academic papers, allowing them to practice structuring coherent arguments in English. Weekly group presentations prompt successful teamwork and individual study skills whilst demonstrating assertiveness and refined vocalisation. Learners express ideas and opinions as individuals with a powerful and unique voice, and display the independence and maturity expected of a student at a prestigious University.



Accommodation

The programme is residential. Students will eat breakfast, lunch and an evening meal within the historic wood pannelled dining hall. All bedrooms are single and well equipped. Some have a shared lounge. There are a maximum of 4 students per shower room. Wash basins are in every bedroom.

Activities and Excursions

As well as an intensive academic programme there will be a wide range of cultural activities to take place every evening and at the weekend. These will be led by true Oxford enthusiasts

Evenings will feature a mixture of academic workshops and cultural activities such as punting, guest speakers, Shakespeare outdoor theatre, guided walking tour of Oxford and its colleges, museum visits and games in the University Park.
