### **Location and Centre**

Oxford is home to the world famous Oxford University, the oldest university in the English speaking world, with teaching of some form being offered as early as 1096. Since then it has grown into one of the world's most celebrated universities, and has given the city a uniquely scholarly atmosphere. A range of academic wonders can be found scattered throughout the city, including medieval college buildings, museums, galleries and bookshops.

Staying residentially at Brasenose, an Oxford University college located between the High Street and the Bodleian library, students have unrivalled access to one of the most highly regarded educational institutions on the planet. As a result of the dynamic tuition, participations on these programmes refine their social eloquence and mastery in the specificity of the English language.

The Oxford College Experience at Brasenose offers ambitious and motivated 14-17 year olds the opportunity to prepare for an aspirational, professional future environment through skill-based workshops, field trips and case study analyses.

Morning lessons focus largely on the skills required to study at an English university, including developing appropriate writing styles for a variety of relevant situations. Afternoon sessions are subject-focused, exploring a topic of choice through the media of lectures, case studies and group project work.



## Accommodation

The programme is residential. Students will eat breakfast, lunch and an evening meal within the historic wood pannelled dining hall. All bedrooms are single and well equipped. Some have a shared lounge. There are a maximum of 4 students per shower room. Wash basins are in every bedroom.

## Activities and Excursions

As well as an intensive academic programme there will be a wide range of cultural activities to take place every evening and at the weekend. These will be led by true Oxford enthusiasts.

Evenings will feature a mixture of academic workshops and cultural activities such as punting, guest speakers, Shakespeare outdoor theatre, guided walking tour of Oxford and its colleges, museum visits and games in the University Park.
