Aviation Octorial + 5 & Aviation Octorial + 7.5 Programmes

The Octorial + 5 Programme is a 30 hour intensive programme consisting of 25 hours of group lessons and 5 hours of private tutorials per week. Each day participants study for 5 hours in small general English group classes and have a **one hour tutorial** at 3.15pm.

The Octorial + 7.5 Programme is a 30.5 hour intensive programme consisting of 23 hours of group lessons and 7.5 hours of private tutorials per week. Each day participants study for 5 hours in small general English group classes and have **one and a half hours of tutorials** at 3.15pm.

Private tutorials are a chance for students to have lesson content tailored to their specific needs and to have the full attention of our experienced Aviation tutors. We employ a structured, goal-orientated and needs-driven approach which results in rapid progression.
