



Student success – Fabio Pessoa Rodrigues, Brazil



Fabio spent 8 weeks at OISE London. It was his first visit to London and the UK so it was a formative experience for him on many levels.

Fabio's focus was to strengthen his communication skills in English on both a social and professional level. As someone who enjoys travelling, meeting and conversing with people from different backgrounds and nationalities is important to him. As a civil engineer involved with construction projects that are often joint ventures, international cross-cultural communication in business is key. Fabio aimed to increase his vocabulary and use of expressions/phrases in a formal and informal context (written and spoken).

He participated well in class, leading discussions and exchanging ideas. He worked very hard at improving his communication through focused exercises on his pronunciation, intonation and general verbal skills, as well as the finer points of language such as being able to share an opinion diplomatically. Continued practise of negotiation and presentation skills with weekly group tasks have helped develop his use of business English vocabulary in a variety of professional contexts.

As a result of his studies he:

- increased his knowledge of cultures and cultural differences and these now inform his use of language
- developed his self-confidence in order to make presentations in front of an audience
- revised and practised grammar structures and form and enhanced his accuracy in spoken and written contexts
- plans, designs and gives strong presentations, understanding the difference between formal and informal language when appropriate
- participates in business meetings confidently and effectively, asking for and giving information on past, current and potential construction projects.
