Founded in 1596, Sidney Sussex is one of the most historic and architecturally appealing Colleges in the University, and certainly one of the most interesting.

One of its more infamous and controversial alumni, was Oliver Cromwell who has been voted as one of the 10 most influential people in the history of England and whose head is now buried in the College grounds after being posthumously executed by Charles II in 1659.

The College is situated in the heart of Cambridge, 15 minutes' walk from the school, offering a true experience of what it's like to be a student at one of the world's top academic centres.

The contemporary residential campus is positioned 300 meters from the College and has single room accommodation, with shared & en-suite bathrooms.

Breakfast is served in the College dining room each morning and dinner, at the Cambridge University Centre each evening. The residence has WiFi throughout and laundry facilities.
