We are here to make sure you reach your goals and that means checking that you are working effectively and making progress. We will challenge you, push you and ask you to be courageous and take chances, make mistakes.

Before you arrive we will send you a needs analysis. Your answers will help us understand your learning experiences to date, your priorities when you come to Bristol and your goals. We may test your English at this stage.

On your first Monday we will welcome you to the school, provide with essential details and then test your English to make certain you are put in the correct level classes and again to find out more about you and your objectives.

By mid-morning you will have started your lessons and there will be ongoing monitoring of you work, participation and progress by your teachers and the Academic Manager.

In addition to informal assessments, you will have weekly tests to check you have made headway that week and monthly level tests to gauge if you need to move to a higher level.

All of your test scores are recorded and made available to you. It is important that we work together to help you reach your goals.

You will be assigned a coach who will meet with you each week to talk to you about your studies. This will give you the chance to discuss any problems you may have and they will also work with you to set milestones on the way to your goals. Plus they will highlight areas that require attention and push you to succeed.

When you eventually leave us, we will provide a number of study tips, websites, etc that will help you continue to develop your English.

Throughout your stay at OISE Bristol we are always happy to talk to you about your progress, to offer assistance if you are having difficulties and provide advice when you need it.
