Your intensive programme at OISE London

The Quatorial Programme

This course offers a variety of classes which complement each other to provide you with a fully rounded programme. Classes begin at 8:30 daily and you will have a full-day programme.

The Tutorial Programme

These are one-to-one lessons. The lesson content will be designed to meet your individual English language learning requirements following receipt of your pre-course questionnaire. It is possible to request specialist topics such as Banking & Finance, Law, or Tourism in these lessons. The programme begins daily at 8:30 am with a short group class, News Review, and the Tutorials start at 9.00am unless you have requested an alternative time.

Leisure Programme

After classes we organise a daily teacher-led activity offering the opportunity to put into practise the language you have learnt that day in a relaxed, social environment. Events include tours of London, excursions to art galleries and museums, visits to restaurants and to our local pub on a Friday.

Travel to the school


OISE London is centrally located in London's stylish area of Fitzrovia. We are a short walk from Oxford Circus, Tottenham Court Road and Goodge Street stations. These stations are served by the Northern (black), Central (red), Victoria (light blue) and Bakerloo (brown) underground lines.
