



GETTING TO CAMBRIDGE

There are several ways of arriving in Cambridge.

TAXI

Taxi transfers are available from all major UK airports.

The cost of a one-way transfer is:

Heathrow	155 GBP
Gatwick	165 GBP
London City	120 GBP
Luton	95 GBP
Stansted	75 GBP
Central London	115 GBP

You will be met as you leave the customs area, by a driver from Panther Taxis (+ 44 1223 715 715). The person meeting you will hold a sign with **your name** on it and the OISE logo. If for any reason you do not see the driver or you have been delayed, please go to the Information Desk and ask them to 'page' the driver.

Please wait at the Information Desk until the driver has found you.

Your driver will take you directly to your host family/ alternative.

TRAIN

By far the most convenient way to travel to Cambridge is by train:

from **London King's Cross** 50 minutes direct

from **London Stansted** 30 minutes direct.

from **London Heathrow** you can take the Heathrow express to Paddington Station and then take the London Underground (Metropolitan Line) to King's Cross and take the direct train to Cambridge.

from **London Gatwick** take the Gatwick Express to King's Cross and then direct train to Cambridge

from **London St Pancras** Eurostar terminal follow the signs to King's Cross Station (5-minute walk) and take the direct train to Cambridge. Trains leave every 30 minutes.

BUS
