

Summer School at OISE Taunton

Location and Centre

Dating back to Saxon times, Taunton is situated between the Quantock and Blackdown hills in the south west of England, with the beautiful River Tone running through it. The town itself is 50km from Exeter and 80km from Bristol.

The school has a wide range of facilities including a sports hall, a pool and a woodland assault course. It is ideal for the younger student, with a safe and friendly atmosphere.

As all staff live on campus, there is 24-hour supervision, giving the centre a real family feel and encouraging younger learners to flourish in their linguistic abilities in a natural environment.

- 21 hours of tuition per week
- Full board accommodation (dormitories with up to 8 students)
- Organised recreational activities and cultural excursions
- Transfers included for Heathrow (4 hours), Gatwick (5 hours) and Bristol airport (1 hour)

The Summer School Primary Years (21 hours per week, maximum 8 students per class)



Accommodation

Dormitories for 6 to 8 students within the main Taunton building offer a comfortable place to stay where staff are always available to ensure the security and safety of students, as well as offer pastoral care.

Activities and Excursions

Examples of evening activities include swimming, arts and crafts, birds of prey displays, theatre workshops, circus skills, bowling, dance, talent shows, discos, barbecues, casino nights, treasure hunts and games on the field. On Wednesday afternoons students will explore local points of interest in Taunton itself and the surrounding areas. Every Saturday there is a full day excursion to an exciting local attraction such as Crealy Adventure Park, Wookey Hole and Cheddar Gorge or Bristol Zoo. On Sundays there is a full day of games, activities, challenges and workshops, allowing students to continue using English during leisure time.



Travel

Young Learners are greeted by members of the OISE travel team at designated airport, within standard hours, as part of the package. Students arriving in London are then transferred to the Welcome Lounge, a nearby facility with food, refreshments and activities to keep students occupied until they are taken onward to the school.
