Location and Centre

Newbury is a traditional English market town located in Berkshire, only 96km west of London and conveniently placed for some of the most famous and fascinating cities in England, including Oxford and Bath. Newbury also has a rich history of its own; it was the site of two battles and siege warfare during the English Civil war in the 1600s.

OISE Newbury Hall is an impressive Victorian building which dates back to 1859, and was originally a primary school for local children. The interior has been modernised to combine the atmosphere and character of schooling in days gone by with the comfort and excellent facilities of a modern college.

Accommodation

Newbury Hall provides carefully selected homestay and residential accommodation with single, en-suite rooms. Meals are provided in the school dining hall. Special dietary requirements can be considered and vegetarian options are always available.

A full evening leisure programme is provided, encompassing a wide range of interests. Sports include football, swimming, table-tennis, cricket, badminton and basketball. Other activities include photography, gardening, cooking and fashion design. Relevant trips and excursions can be arranged as part of the timetable.



On Wednesday afternoons on The Extended Summer School Curriculum students visit local places such as Oxford, Reading and Newbury town itself.

Travel

Students are greeted by members of the Newbury Hall /OISE courier team from certain airports, within standard hours, as part of the package. Outside of the summer, students are transferred straight from the airport to the school. During the summer months the majority of students will be accompanied from the airport to the Welcome Lounge, a facility with food, refreshments and activities to keep students occupied, until they are taken onward to the school.
