Location and Centre

Wrekin College is situated in the small and typically English market town of Wellington in the county of Shropshire approximately 5 miles from the centre of Telford.

Telford, birthplace of the Industrial Revolution, is one of the UK's fastest growing and most successful new towns.

A safe environment for young learners of all ages, OISE Telford is located in its own extensive grounds with excellent recreational facilities, including tennis courts, heated swimming pool, playing fields and a football pitch. Students also have the opportunity to choose either residential or homestay accommodation.

Accommodation

Accommodation is with a carefully selected host family. With homestay accommodation, OISE guarantees to never place two students of the same mother-tongue in the same home. All host families are thoroughly inspected and their credentials checked.

Activities and Excursions

One evening per week there is a social activity organised for all students. Examples include a barbecue, film night or party.

On Wednesday afternoons students will explore local points of interest in the area, such as Iron Bridge Gorge, Blists Hill Victorian Town and Shrewsbury.

Every Saturday, there is a full-day excursion to a nearby city of cultural interest, such as Chester, Liverpool or Stratford-Upon-Avon.

Travel

Young Learners are greeted by members of the OISE travel team at the designated airports, within standard hours, as part of the package. Students arriving in London are then transferred to the Welcome Lounge, a facility with food, refreshments and activities to keep students occupied until they are taken onward to the school.
