Newbury Hall	Host family: varies, students should expect to share a room. Residence: rooms are en-suite singles.	All meals are provided on-site. Homestay students will arrive in time for breakfast and leave after dinner.
Sherbourne Priors	Rooms are shared between 2 to 4 students.	Students eat in the school hall, there are several choices at each meal.
