



## OISE Bristol Fire Safety Policy

Our premises are very safe, but we take fire safety very seriously. We regularly conduct fire drills to ensure we can safely evacuate the building and our staff know what to do in these circumstances.

On your first day we will explain that we have a routine in the event of a fire or other emergency that may need everyone to leave the building.

You will also be given a tour of the school and shown where the fire exits are. In addition, in all classrooms there are instructions telling you what to do and where to go in an emergency.

We have fire buckets and not fire extinguishers in the school. We took this decision as fire extinguishers are difficult to use and time is important when there is a fire.

If you hear the fire alarm, please leave the school quietly and calmly with your teacher and other students. Do not stop to gather your possessions. When you have left the building, please stay with everyone and listen carefully for further instructions.

If you see a fire in the school, tell someone immediately so the alarm can be raised. Do not try to deal with the problem - please just get help.
