



OISE Bristol Special educational needs & disabilities statement

Please consult us well in advance if you have special learning needs. We can sometimes help students with difficulties with their sight or their hearing but our courses are not suitable for those who are the completely blind or the very deaf. Please tell us in advance if you are dyslexic. If you are planning to take an examination we may be able to make special arrangements.

Mental health issues

We are unable to accept those with significant mental health problems and if in doubt please consult us before enrolling yourself or others with any history of mental health problems so that we can advise.

Physical disability

Our school is accessible for wheelchair users and we do not have stairs.

Inclusions Officer

Our Inclusions Officer is Stuart Spells, the Academic Manager. He advises our teachers of any learning disabilities and you can always contact him at stuart.spell@oise.com if you wish to discuss any issues prior to booking a course.

Teachers may also speak to the Inclusion Officer if they believe a student has learning difficulties that we were not informed about. In these circumstances the matter will be dealt with sensitively.

The Inclusions Officer will then contact the Director of Education at Head Office to receive advice and if necessary appropriate training or consultation.

We cannot guarantee to offer a course that is suitable for all special learning needs, but the more information we have, the more we can do our best to help.
