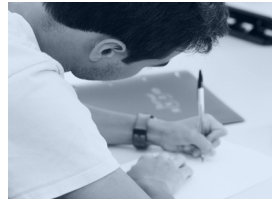


Distance Learning courses for learners aged 8 to 17 - summer 2021

Distance Learning courses are delivered via Zoom by an OISE tutor, and taught in groups of no more than four students. Each course includes 15 hours of tuition per week, and the course price is £555 per week.



For learners aged 8 - 12

Storytelling

Learners develop listening skills, new vocabulary and an understanding of storytelling devices from discussing stories in the class. They are also encouraged to use this inspiration and their imaginations to create their own story, building plot and characters to create a story with a clear beginning, middle and end.

Course dates: Study from 1-5 weeks, with start dates on 05.07.21, 12.07.21, 19.07.21, 26.07.21 and 01.08.21

For learners aged 13 - 17

Preparation for the Cambridge B2 First (FCE) and C1 Advanced (CAE) exams

Students work on the core exam skills of reading, writing, speaking and listening and are familiarised with the exam format to provide them with the confidence and strategies required to achieve the highest possible score.

Course dates: Study from 1-4 weeks, with start dates on 05.07.21, 12.07.21, 19.07.21, 26.07.21

Preparation for the IELTS exam

Learners are coached in the content of the exam and guided with strategies for understanding and navigating the test questions. Students also undertake work on essay writing, vocabulary, comprehension and speaking practice.

Course dates: Study from 1-4 weeks, with start dates on 05.07.21, 12.07.21, 19.07.21, 26.07.21

The Future Diplomat

Participants engage in the skills which are key to becoming an influential diplomat such as interpersonal skills, body language, social etiquette and appropriate conversations, as well as debate, negotiation and speech-writing.

Course dates: A one week course, with start dates on 05.07.21 and 19.07.21

The Future Orator

Students study the oracy skills necessary to speak more eloquently, articulate ideas and thoughts, influence others through talk, collaborate with peers and have the confidence to express their views.

Course dates: A one week course, with start dates on 12.07.21 and 26.07.21

The Future Journalist

Participants are coached in the skills needed to create a compelling written narrative in a range of styles. Tutors guide learners through the copywriting process, from research and creating a structure to editing and polishing the final article.

Course dates: A one week course, with start dates on 02.08.21 and 09.08.21

Fine tuning of English language fluidity and accuracy

Students focus on fine-tuning their communicative use of the English language. Core skills lessons equip students with the necessary skills in grammar, comprehension and accuracy, and communication skills workshops develop fluency.
